1. Introduction

Our website, www.navisite.com (hereinafter: "the website"), uses cookies and other related technologies. In this document, we will inform you about the use of cookies on our website.

2. What Are Cookies?

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyze web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

3. What Are Scripts?

A script is a program code that is used to make websites function interactively. This code is executed on the server or on your device.

4. What Is a Web Beacon?

A web beacon is a small, invisible piece of text or image on a website that is used to monitor traffic on a website. In order to do this, various data about you is stored using web beacons.

5. Consent

When you make a visit to our website, a pop-up with an explanation about cookies is displayed. You have the rights to opt-out and to object to the further use of cookies. You may also disable the use of cookies on your internet browser; this may affect the website functionality.

6. Third Parties

We have made appropriate agreements about the use of cookies with third parties that place cookies. We cannot assure that these third parties handle your personal information in a secured manner (e.g., Google is considered an interdependent data controller). We highly recommend you read through the privacy statement of these companies.

7. Cookies

7.a. Technical or Functional Cookies

Some cookies ensure that certain parts of the website work properly and that your user preferences remain known. By placing functional cookies, we make it easier for you to visit our website. This way, you do not need to repeatedly enter the same information when visiting our website and, for example, the items remain in your shopping cart until you have paid. We may place these cookies without your consent.

7.b. Advertising Cookies

When visitors come to our site, third parties may place cookies on their browsers for targeted advertising purposes. Visitors can opt-out of receiving personalized advertising by going to networkadvertising.org/choices.

7.c. Social Media

On our website we have included buttons for LinkedIn, YouTube, Facebook and Twitter to promote webpages on such social networks. These buttons work using pieces of code coming from such social media themselves. This code places cookies. These social media buttons also can store and process certain information, so a personalized advertisement can be shown to you.

Please read the privacy statement of these social networks (which can change regularly) to read what they do with your (personal) data, which they process using these cookies.

8. Placed Cookies

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website, by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

You may control cookies, including preventing or stopping the installation and storage of cookies, through your browser settings and other tools. If you do so, our website may not function correctly. Please refer to the Help feature of your browser for information on disabling cookies.

9. Your Rights with Respect To Personal Data

- You may submit a request for access to the data we process about you.
- You may request an overview of the data we process about you.
- You may request the correction or deletion of data that is incorrect or no longer relevant.



10. Enabling/Disabling and Deleting Cookies

You can use your internet browser to automatically or manually delete cookies. You can also specify that certain cookies may not be placed. Another option is to change the settings of your internet browser so that you receive a message each time a cookie is placed.
